




If you love snakes and ladders then you'll love tracks and tunnels.

The first player throws the dice and moves there counter the corresponding places. The next player does the same and all the players take it in turns to throw and move. The winner of the game is the first player to get to the top station on square 100.

Now if a player lands on the bottom end of a track they move UP to the top of that track. Any player landing on the top of a tunnel has to move down to the bottom of that tunnel. If you land anywhere else on a track or tunnel just continue as normal.

In this book I'm going to take you on a journey through the Victorian Railways to prove that the railways were a lot of things - But romantic wasn't one of them


CRASHES AND ACCIDENTS
